

# VERMONT LAW: Banned from Landfills

<b>SOLID WASTE (HAULER MANDATED) RECYCLABLES</b>
<b>GLASS:</b> bottles & jars from food & beverages
<b>METAL:</b>
aluminum and steel cans (deposit & other) foils & pie pans
<b>PAPER:</b>
white & colored cardstock newspaper corrugated cardboard paper bags softcover books magazines, catalogs
<b>PLASTIC:</b> PET & HDPE containers, bottles and jugs
<b>COMPOST</b>
food waste * see ANR Universal Recycling Timeline yard waste *see ANR Universal Recycling Timeline
<b>PAINT</b>
paint *latex okay if dried stripper thinner varnish
<b>BATTERIES</b>
button cell lead acid rechargeable: lithium-ion, NiCad, Nickel-metal-hydride
<b>HAZARDOUS &amp; DANGEROUS</b>
aerosol cans (not emptied) acids ammunition Cleaning chemicals: drain cleaner, oven cleaner, toilet bowl cleaner, chlorine bleach, ammonia based cleaners, metal and furniture polishes, spot cleaners, disinfectants, etc. explosives fertilizer firework flares gasoline hot ashes pesticides pool chemicals propane cylinders & other gas cylinders unprotected "sharps"

<b>MERCURY</b>
barometers CFL bulbs fluorescent tubes thermometers & thermostats
<b>ELECTRONICS</b>
chargers computers digital converter boxes DVD players monitors PDAs personal music players phones printers stereos TVs VCRs video game consoles
<b>MEDICAL</b>
Regulated Medical Waste or "infectious waste"
<b>TIRES</b>
<b>OIL</b>
Oil, used oil & used oil filters
<b>WHITE GOODS</b>
dishwashers dryers freezers refrigerators stoves washers
<b>ARCHITECTURAL</b>
asphalt shingles drywall metal wood: clean wood, and plywood, and oriented strand board *If > 40 cu/yards & within 20 miles of C&D recycling facility
