

Weatherization Outreach Internship

Job Description:

The Weatherization Outreach Intern will assist the Program Coordinator in the "Bridging the Energy Gap: Sustainable Solutions for Low-Income Families" project. Tasks will include assisting with public outreach through written articles, pictures, and social media posts, educational and tabling at events, helping to coordinate and staff the annual Woodstock [Window Dressers](#) build, and working with residents to move energy projects forward.

This position is an opportunity to grow skills/gain experience in: nonprofit structure and culture, volunteer management, community engagement, low-income weatherization, and grantmaking.

Location:

Primarily remote work with some in-person events in the Upper Valley. The Weatherization Intern should plan to be available to work in person in Woodstock during the Window Dressers build. Exact shifts will be determined, but the build is scheduled for Nov 5th-12th. Must have reliable transportation to report to Window Dressers build for all scheduled shifts, and other in-person events as needed.

Hours and Compensation:

\$18/ hour, 9.5 hours per week – flexible schedule but with majority availability during normal business hours. Longer hours (roughly 40) will be expected during the Window Dressers build (Nov 5th-12th), including some weekend and evening shifts.
